Hair Straighteners

CRITERIA

- ♦ Minimum of 4 uses in a 12 month period
- Any straightener containing Formaldehyde or Phthalates chemicals
- ◆ Diagnosis of one of the following cancers....
 Uterine Endometrial Ovarian

OR Uterine fibroids requiring hysterectomy

- ♦ One or more year(s) between use and diagnosis
- ♦ Either commercial or personal use

Women who use chemical hair straighteners and relaxers may have a higher risk of uterine cancer, according to a new study from researchers at the US National Institutes of Health (NIH). The study findings were published on October 17, 2022, in the Journal of the National Cancer Institute.

Chemical exposure from hair product use, especially straighteners, could be more concerning than other personal care products due to increased absorption through the scalp which may be exacerbated by burns and lesions caused by straighteners.
